As we navigate through these trying times, our Y team continues to evolve in establishing the new normal, ensuring that we remain connected with our community, serving families in need, and ensuring we remain a vibrant part of our communities as we work towards fully re-opening Y facilities.

The challenge for all of us during these past four months has been to not let social distancing keep us apart. Efforts put forth by the Y to meet this challenge include:

- providing child care services for essential workers
- implementing online learning opportunities for pre-K and school-age children
- creating virtual on-line offerings that range from yoga and Zumba classes to book club sessions
- increasing telephone-outreach initiatives to protect our most vulnerable members, particularly seniors
- collecting hundreds of food items for area food-pantries for distribution to those in need

Beginning August 1, we will be offering open, outdoor morning lap-swimming at the Oakcrest Community Pool for <u>all</u> of our members. Our child care programs have now re-opened, as well as summer camp programming at four locations. We have been working with our local school districts to support their back-to-school fall schedules to ensure that families who rely on our assistance have the availability of flexible child care as they return to the workplace.
